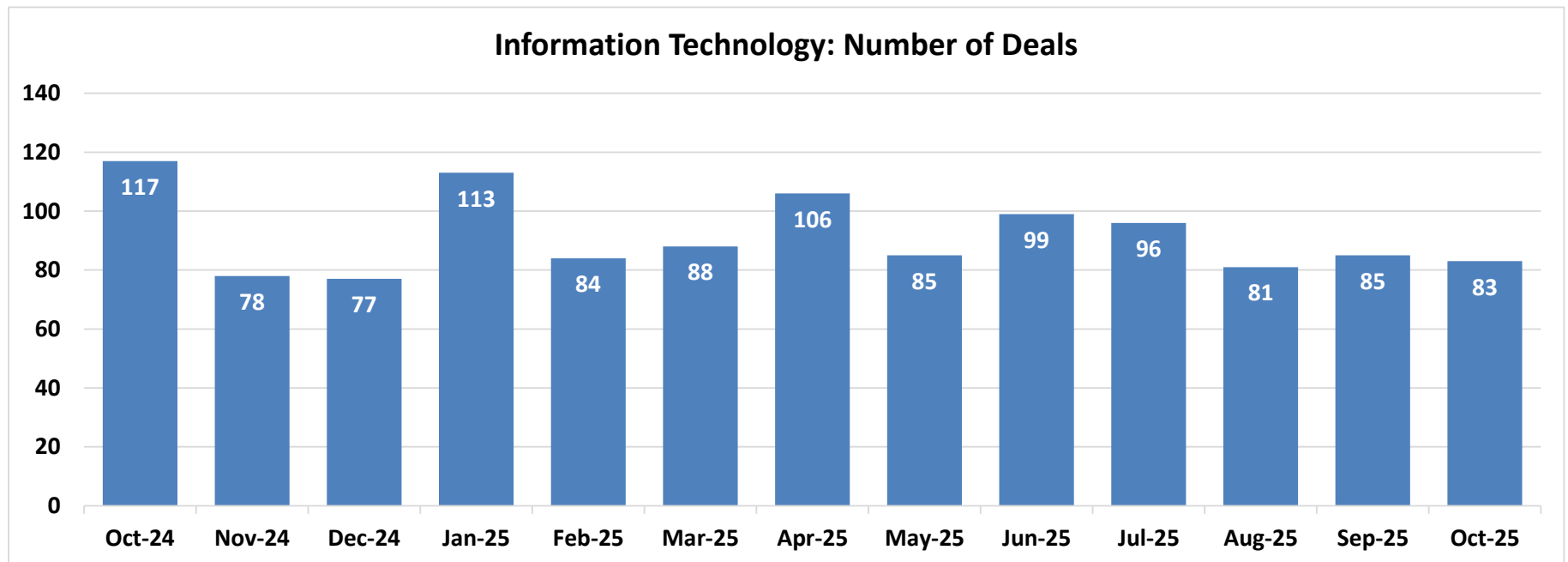


Information Technology Deals for October 2025

There were 83 completed U.S. private equity deals in the Information Technology sector during the month of October. The number of deal transactions were down approximately 2% from September. There was a 29% decline in the number of Information Technology deals compared to October 2024.
