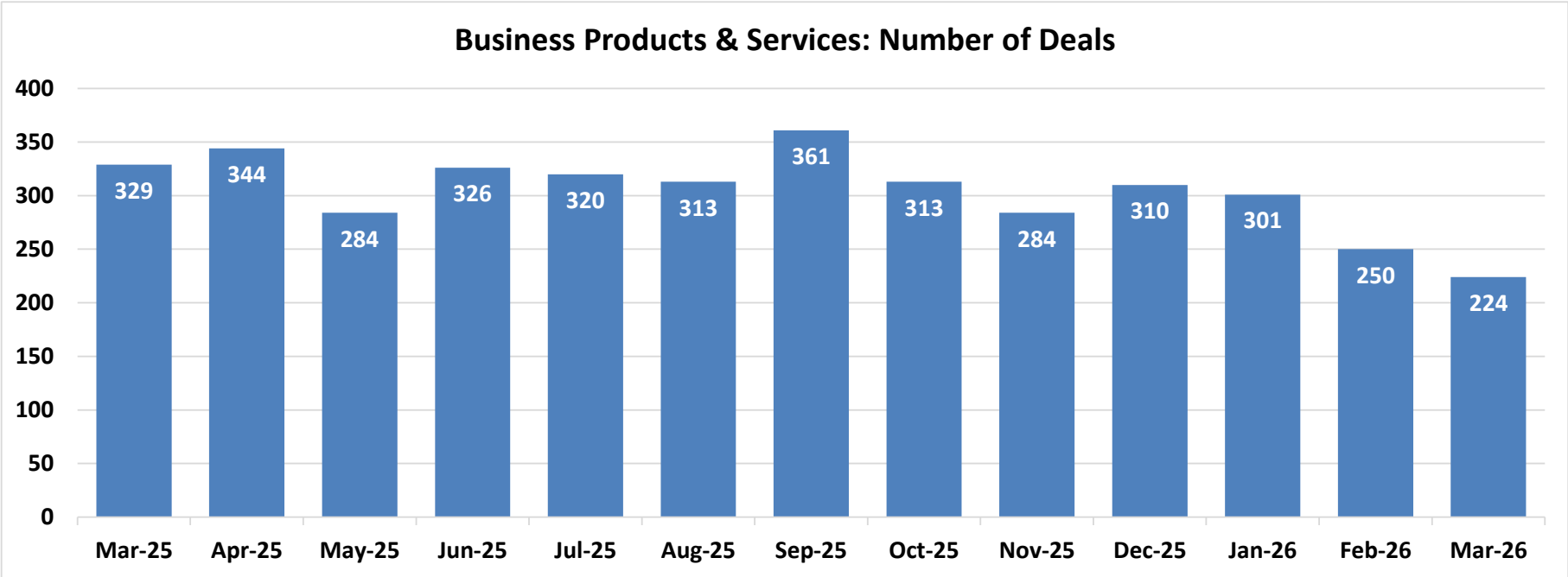


# Business Products and Services Deals for March 2026

The number of deal transactions decreased 10% when compared to February's deal count. There was a 32% decline in the number of Business Products & Services deals compared to March 2025.
