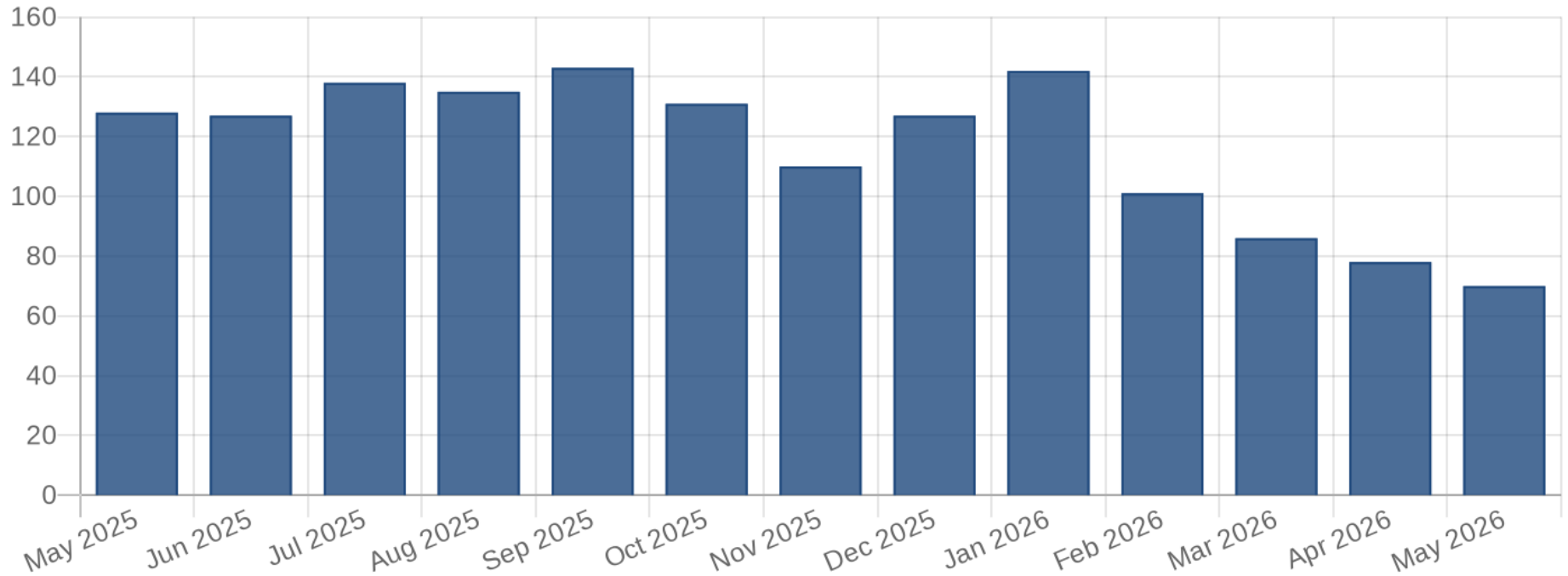


Consumer Products and Services Deals for May 2026

There were 70 completed U.S. private equity deals in the Consumer Products & Services sector during the month of May. The number of deal transactions decreased 10.3% when compared to April's deal count. There was a 45.3% decline in the number of Consumer Products & Services deals compared to May 2025.
