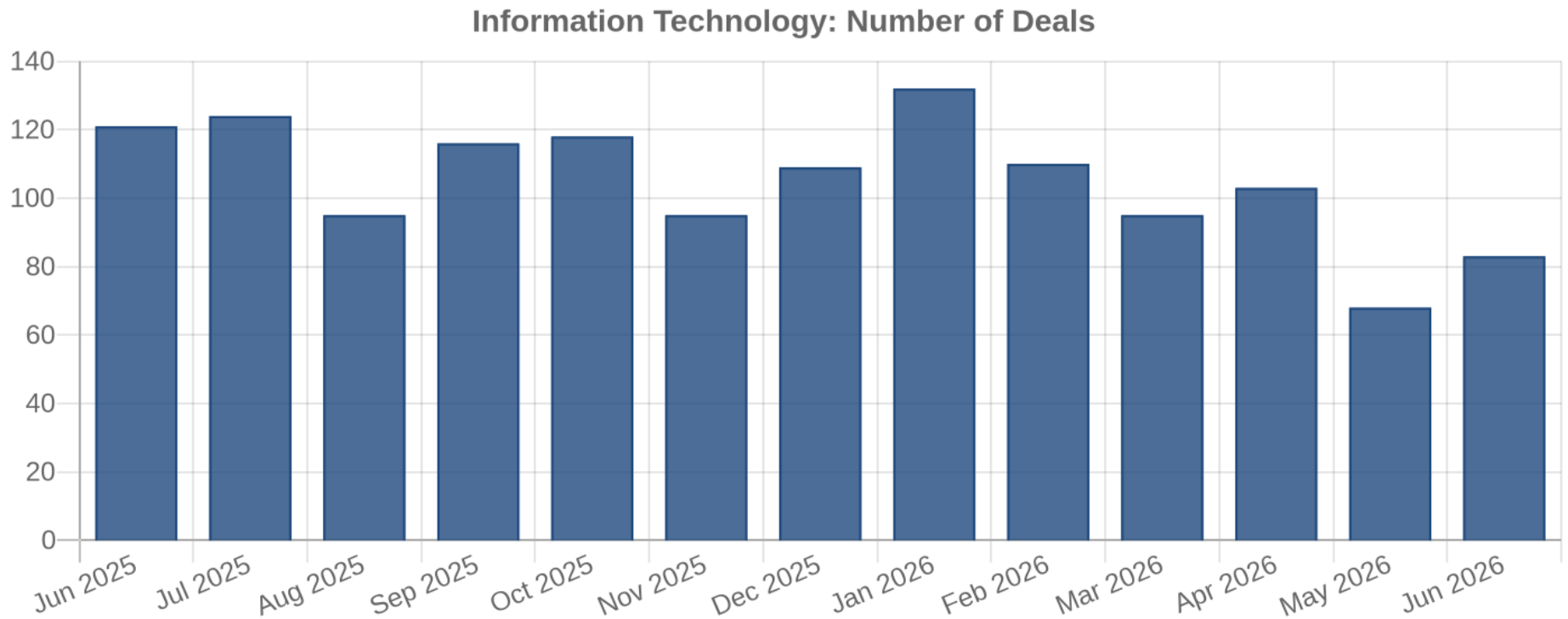


Information Technology Deals for June 2026

There were 83 completed U.S. private equity deals in the Information Technology sector during the month of June. The number of deal transactions increased 22.1% when compared to May's deal count. There was a 31.4% decline in the number of Information Technology deals compared to June 2025.
