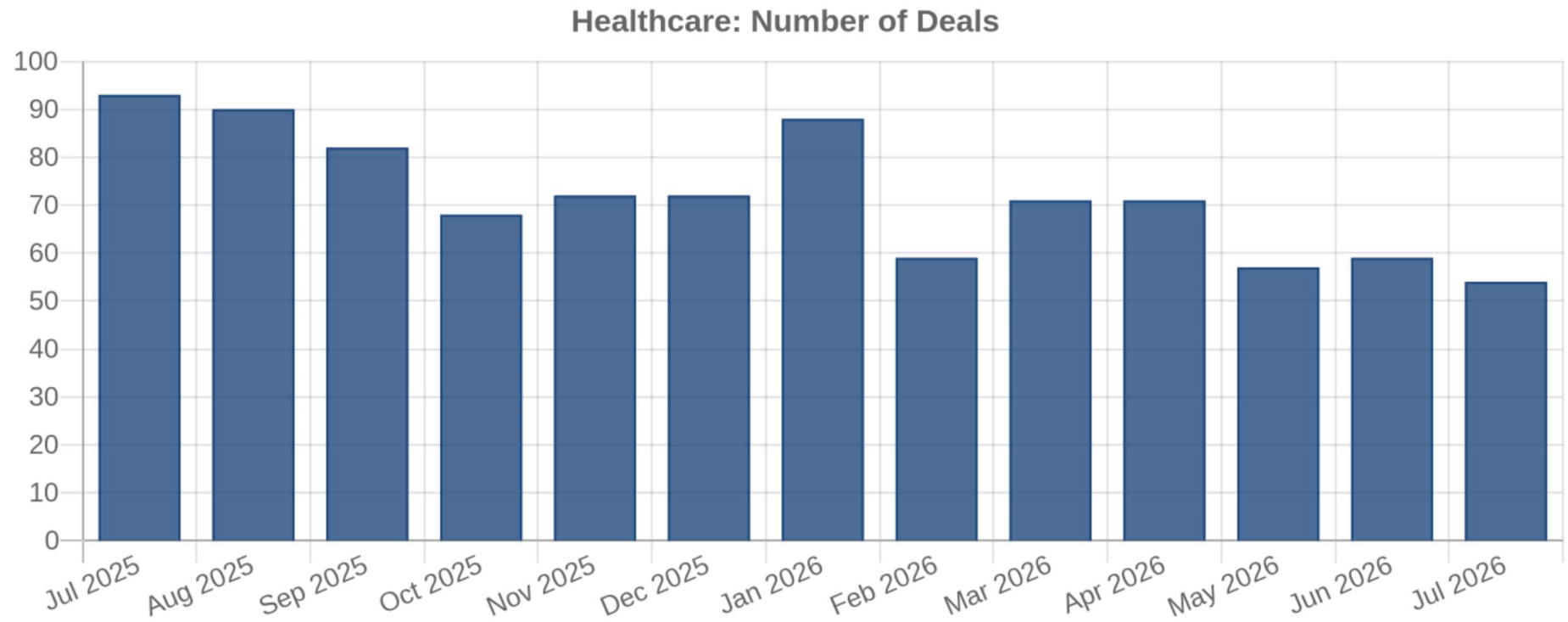


Healthcare Deals for July 2026

There were 54 completed U.S. private equity deals in the Healthcare sector during the month of July. The number of deal transactions decreased 8.5% when compared to June's deal count. There was a 41.9% decline in the number of Healthcare deals compared to July 2025.
