The company offers indoor energy efficiency ratings, enabling clients to reduce their utility bills.	The home energy division of Ensign Building Solutions was acquired by DPIS Builder Services, via its financial sponsor Saw Mill Capital, through an LBO on April 27, 2021 for an undisclosed sum.
Infiniti Energy	Developer of solar energy assets in the Northeast and Mid Atlantic regions. The company offers services catering to engineering, development and construction of commercial and utility-scale solar projects to clients.	The company received \$60 million of development capital from Upper Bay Infrastructure Partners on April 7, 2021. Upper Bay Infrastructure Partners expects a total project pipeline investment opportunity in the company in excess of \$200 million over the next three years.
North American Substation Services	Provider of critical power transmission services in Altamonte Springs, Florida. The company is a leading independent service provider for mission-critical electrical transmission and distribution infrastructure that prevents costly equipment failure by maintaining and extending the life of aging utility infrastructure across the United States of America.	The company was acquired by Arcline Investment Management through an LBO in April 19, 2021 for an undisclosed sum.
Stonehill Environmental Partners	Provider of energy infrastructure services for the oil and gas industry. The company offers services catering to designing, building, owning and operating fixed water pipelines, recycling and disposal assets to clients.	The company was acquired by Golden Gate Capital through an LBO on April 15, 2021 for an undisclosed sum.
